Volunteer / Helper Form:

This event will need volunteers and helpers to ensure its success, numbers required will depend on entries but clubs should plan on two helpers per team and one per individual. Where possible this will be reduced. It is the clubs responsibility to replace any volunteers/helpers who fail to attend or need to leave early.

At the event there will be a volunteer/helper ambassador who will co-ordinate the deployment throughout the day. Clubs must ensure that helpers and volunteers have access to wet weather clothing and if required a vehicle if fence judging. At the discretion of the organiser roles maybe shared where appropriate, this may not always be possible in order to maintain continuity or if the role requires a specific briefing i.e. fence judges, scorers and dressage writers. The organiser may re-deploy volunteers/helpers if required to assist in another part of the event. Abuse of volunteers/helpers will not be tolerated and may lead to disciplinary action.

- Volunteers / helpers will be supplied with equipment to carry out the nominated role but it is the responsibility of clubs to ensure their members are in possession of suitable clothing and foot ware for their respective role.
- Refreshments and pack lunch will be provided for those doing a full day.
- A named volunteer / helper ambassador will be appointed by the organiser to co-ordinate the deployment at the event.
